Introduction

Content	This document contains an overview of all European Partnerships within Horizon Europe and clarifies possibilities for Danish universities and researchers within the partnerships, specifically in relation to possibilities of being part of the organizational structure of the European Partnerships, funding and influencing calls.
Purpose	<p>This paper deals with the European Partnerships in Horizon Europe only and will assist universities to understand the possibilities for the involvement of researchers and universities.</p> <p>European Partnerships in Horizon Europe are an integral part of pillar II. Pillar II is characterised by European political agreed priorities implemented through the cluster-specific work programmes, Missions and the European Partnerships. The Partnerships take up 40% of the pillar II budget meaning that the Partnerships get an overall contribution from the European Commission of approx. 21 billion EUR in 2021-2027.</p> <p>Partnerships pertain to cluster 1: Health, cluster 4: Digital, Industry and Space, cluster 5: Climate, Energy and Mobility as well as cluster 6: Food, Bioeconomy, Natural resources, Agriculture and Environment. The European Partnerships are classified into three types: Co-programmed, Co-funded and Institutionalized partnerships.</p> <p>Universities can be involved in the European Partnerships in two ways: 1). Directly by applying for calls and/or 2). Joining the governing structure by being a member or possible working groups/advisory board etc. of the European Partnerships. Whether applying for calls or joining governing structures, European Partnerships offer European network opportunities for researchers and universities.</p> <p>It is relevant to know that often the calls of the European Partnerships have higher success rates and can offer higher overhead funding.</p> <p>For general information about European Partnerships see link. ERA-Learn is also a rich source of information. Also the Danish Ministry (UFM) has a comprehensive overview of the partnerships from an applicants point of view.</p> <p>Please note that pillar III's European Institute of Innovation and Technology Knowledge and Innovation Communities (KICs) are also considered European Partnerships. However, these Partnerships are fundamentally different and are currently outside of the scope of this document except for an overview at the end of this document.</p> <p><i>Special thanks for input and intelligence to Jonas Toft Ludvigsen from the Danish Ministry of Higher Education and Science.</i></p>

General information	<p>Co-programmed Partnerships between the Commission and mostly private (and sometimes public) partners. A memorandum of understanding is the basis for the cooperation in these partnerships, as it specifies the partnership's objectives, the commitments from both sides and the governance structure. These partnerships are implemented through open calls in the Horizon Europe work programmes for the relevant clusters, formulated by the partnership but typically open to all.</p> <p>These Partnerships follow the contractual Public-Private-Partnerships (cPPPs) under H2020 ex: AI-Data-Robotics, Made in Europe, BATT4EU, Zero-emission waterborne transport.</p>	<p>Co-funded Partnerships are based on grant agreements between the Commission and consortia of partners. The Partnership outlines objectives, key performance and impact indicators, and outputs to be delivered, based on the commitment of the partners and integration of their relevant activities. This type of European Partnership is suited to public authorities, but it is also possible to include foundations and international partners.</p> <p>These Partnerships are the successors of the ERA-NETs under H2020 ex: Personalized Medicine, ERA for Health, Clean Energy Transition, Water4All.</p>	<p>Institutionalized Partnerships are based on individual legal acts and have multiannual agreements. These partnerships also include the KICs in pillar III.</p> <p>Article 185 institutionalized partnerships are collaborations between public actors, while article 187 institutionalized partnerships are collaborations between public and private actors. Many of these partnerships have representatives from academia, for example through an umbrella organization. Information about governance structure and membership can usually be found on the Partnership websites.</p> <p>Clean Hydrogen is as an example the successor of Fuel Cells and Hydrogen Joint Undertaking under H2020.</p>
Possibilities to influence calls through the European Partnership	<p>Co-Programmed Partnerships usually require a membership fee either financially or in-kind.</p> <p>Universities can influence the formulation, aim and direction of future calls by getting on board the Partnership structure (governing board/ working groups etc.) or through the Programme Committee where DK is officially represented. DK universities have possibilities to provide their input to the Programme Committee through the Danish reference group structure.</p>	<p>Direct membership after the establishment of the partnership is not possible.</p> <p>Influence will go through the national funding body - typically the Innovation Fund Denmark. Further, the Partnership structure often allows for influence through participation in the working groups.</p>	<p>Possibilities to influence these European Partnerships vary.</p> <p>Some Institutionalized Partnerships have independent governing boards for which researchers can apply to become a member. Membership of an Institutionalized Partnership will be through a European Industry Association.</p> <p>For KICs membership is based on annual fees - often significant annual fees for the participating institutions.</p>
Funding eligibility through calls	<p>Universities and researchers are eligible for funding and eligible to apply for all calls.</p>	<p>Funding for universities and researchers is possible if DK participates and contributes to the call, or if call provisions allow for funded participation. See flagged co-funded Partnerships.</p>	<p>Funding for universities and researchers is by default possible unless derogations in the basic act or in the annual work programme limit eligibility for funding.</p>
Funding rate through calls	<p>Universities and researchers can typically expect a 100% funding rate. Companies can have a lower funding rate (60% is being piloted in Horizon Europe).</p>	<p>Up to 100% depending on the national funding body.</p> <p>Co-funded Partnerships where e.g. the Innovation Fund Denmark participates with funding offer 90% funding for universities and researchers as well as an overhead rate of 40%. For more information about guidelines for Partnerships co-funded by Innovation Fund Denmark see link.</p>	<p>Varying funding rates, but in general, Institutionalized Partnerships follow Horizon Europe rules and universities typically get 100%. 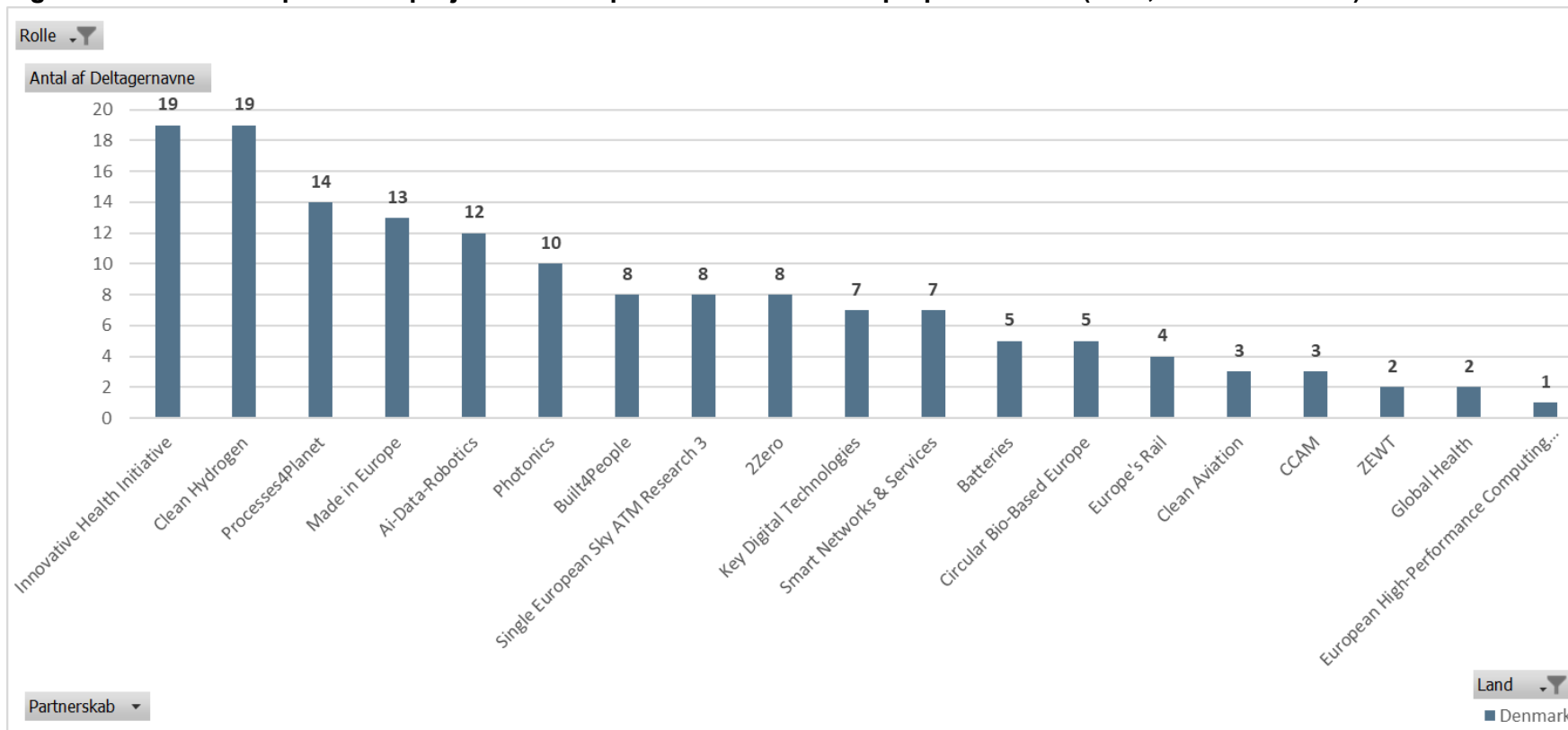
